

IASLT stands for the Irish Association of Speech and Language Therapists.

New Graduate Membership Categories include:

- New graduate member (€180 per year)
- New graduate member practicing overseas (€140 per year)
- Non-practicing new graduate (€110 per year)

The membership year starts from the date of joining and renewal is due 12 months after this date.

You must renew on time. Any break in membership will impact on your professional indemnity insurance.

How to join

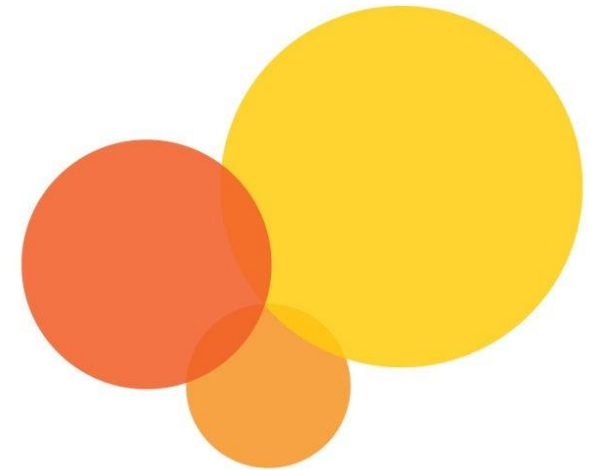
- Log on to www.iaslt.ie

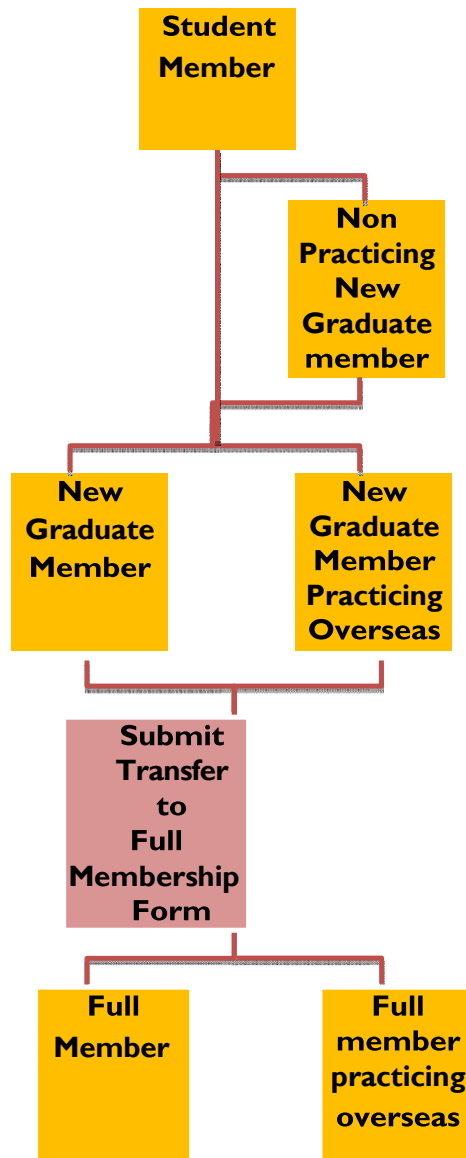

Requirements for new graduate membership

- You must hold a recognised professional qualification in speech and language therapy.
- If you qualified and work outside the Republic of Ireland (ROI), your qualification must be validated by IASLT.
- If you work in the ROI, your qualification must be validated by CORU.
- You may hold new graduate membership for a maximum of two membership years.
- You must agree to meet IASLT standards for continuing professional development. New graduate members are not subject to audit.

Where to from here?

From new graduate membership categories, you may, as appropriate, transfer to Full, Full Member Practicing Overseas or to Non-Practicing Membership.

Features of new graduate membership

- Full voting rights at IASLT meetings (within ROI only – not valid if practicing overseas)
- Professional Indemnity and Fitness To Practise insurances (within ROI only – not valid if practicing overseas) – must meet IASLT supervision requirements.
- Access to members' area of IASLT website
- Access to IASLT online forum
- Receive IASLT publications (*Update* magazine and *Journal of Clinical Speech and Language Studies*)
- Access to members only CPD events
- Use of the title *New Graduate MIASLT*
- Eligible to apply for full membership after one full year of clinical practice as a new graduate member.
