Membership Categories are for SLTs who qualified in the Republic of Ireland, or have had their qualifications recognised by the IASLT

Categories include:

- New Graduate member (€180 per year)
- New graduate member practising overseas (€140 per year)

The membership year starts from the date of joining and renewal is due 12 months after this date.

You must renew on time. Any break in membership will impact on your professional indemnity insurance and your eligibility for a letter of good standing.

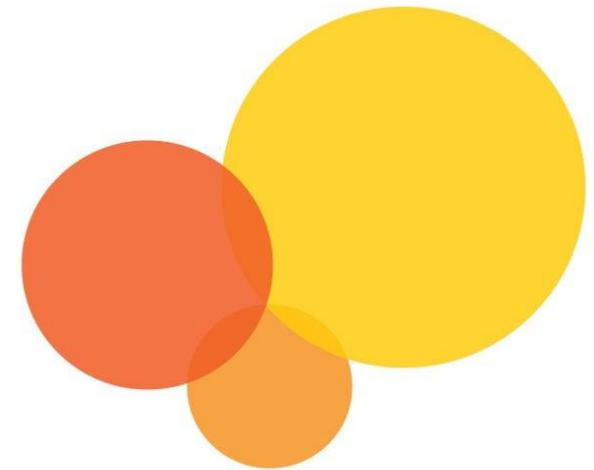
- Log on to www.iaslt.ie

Requirements for New Graduate Membership

- You must hold a recognised professional qualification in speech and language therapy
- If you qualified outside ROI your qualification must be recognised by IASLT.
- New graduate members may transfer to Full Membership on completion of Transfer to Full Membership Form.
- The Transfer to Full Membership competencies must be signed off by a Full Member of IASLT.

Features of New Graduate Membership

- Fitness to Practise Insurance (this applies to new graduate members working in the ROI)
- Professional indemnity insurance (this applies to new graduate members working in the ROI)
- Access to members' area of IASLT website
- Voting rights at IASLT meetings (does not apply to new graduate member practising overseas)
- Receive IASLT publications (*Update* magazine and *Journal of Clinical Speech and Language Studies*)
- Use of the title *New Graduate MIASLT* if in the practising categories
- Access to members only CPD events
