- Cost: €60

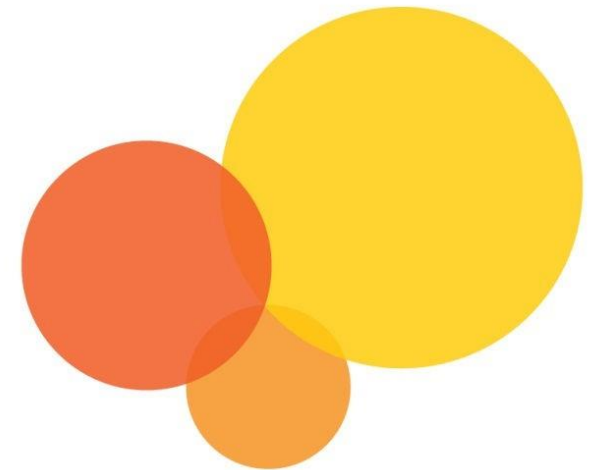
The membership year starts from the date of joining and renewal is due 12 months after this date.

Non-Practising & Retired Membership Categories

Features of non-practising & retired membership

- Lower cost than other membership categories
- Access to members' area of IASLT website
- Access to IASLT online forum
- Receive IASLT publications (*Update* magazine and *Journal of Clinical Speech and Language Studies*)
- Access to members only CPD events.
- Stay connected to IASLT Community.
- Contribute to IASLT Committees and working groups.
- Use your skills to support PR and Lobbying functions.
- Opportunities to continue to influence policy development and plans through responses and submissions.
- Opportunities to advise IASLT Council.

Requirements for non-practising & retired membership

- You must hold a recognised professional qualification in speech and language therapy
- If you qualified outside the Republic of Ireland, your qualification must be recognised by IASLT and CORU.
- You must not be practicing as an SLT.

Where to from here?

- From non-practising New Graduate membership, you may transfer to New Graduate membership or New Graduate Overseas membership.
- From non-practising membership, you must transfer to Provisional membership and follow the *IASLT Return to Practice Guidelines* in advance of transfer to Full membership.
