

Step 1:

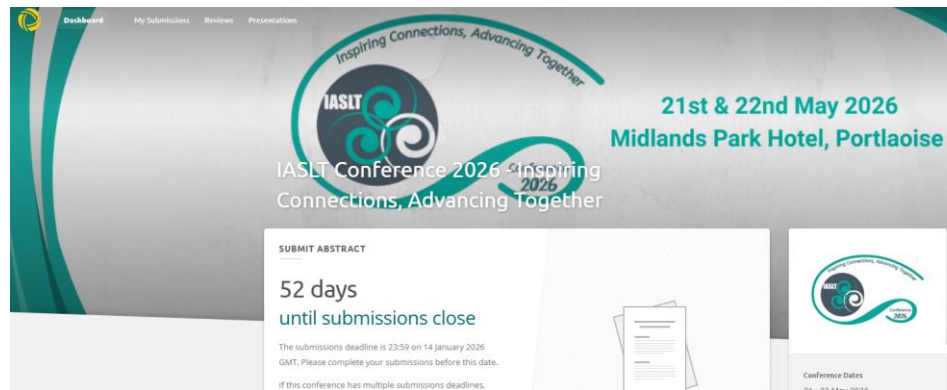
Follow the relevant steps to create a new account or log in to an existing account.

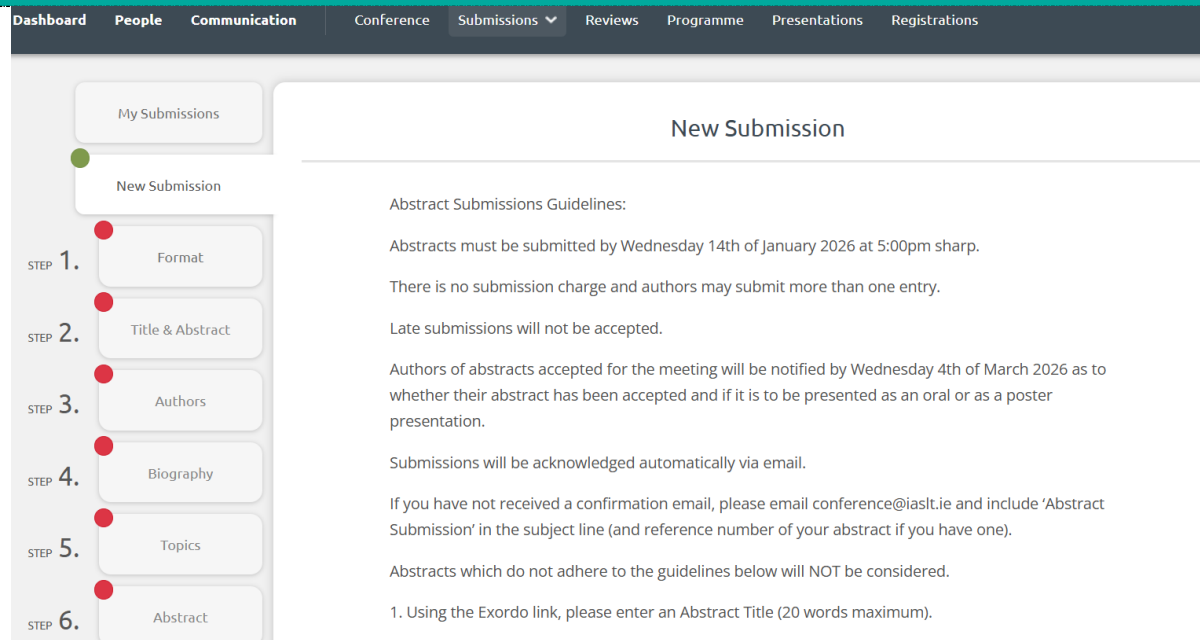


