
You can access the IASLT Exordo platform: here.

1. Using the Exordo link, please enter an Abstract Title (20 words maximum).

Review the submission guideline information, and select "Next" My Submissions **New Submission New Submission** Abstract Submissions Guidelines: Abstracts must be submitted by Wednesday 14th of January 2026 at 5:00pm sharp. 


Title & Abstract:

Submissions will be saved automatically, once the process of inputting information has begun.







